Model A Trip Plan Outline - 2025

Thursday - April 24 -

Morning -

Meet at Casey's service station in Collinsville at 9:30 am. Fuel all cars, use restroom, etc. Driver's meeting. Hand out gift bags. Organize into three groups. Line up in parking lot and along the street on west side of Casey's. Depart at 10:00 am with groups spaced 15 minutes apart. Last group depart at 10:30 am. Use OK Hwy 11 and US Hwy 60 to drive to Pawhuska.

Afternoon -

Have lunch at P-Town Pizza (515 Kihkah Ave, Pawhuska) from 12:00 to 1:30 pm. Drive to Immaculate Conception Catholic Church (1314 Lynn Ave., Pawhuska), a historic building on the National Register of Historic Places, and tour the stained glass windows from 1:30 - 2:45 pm. Leave Pawhuska at 2:45 pm to drive to Ponca City. Use US Hwy 60, Hwy 18 and Hwy 11 west through Shidler and Kaw City, then south on US 77 (14th St).

Check-in at Holiday Inn Express at 2809 N 14th after 3:00 pm. Pick up welcome packets at hotel meeting room. This meeting room is for our exclusive use until Sunday.

Group dinner at Frazier's Restaurant, (3113 Hwy 60) at 6:30 pm. Pay on your own.

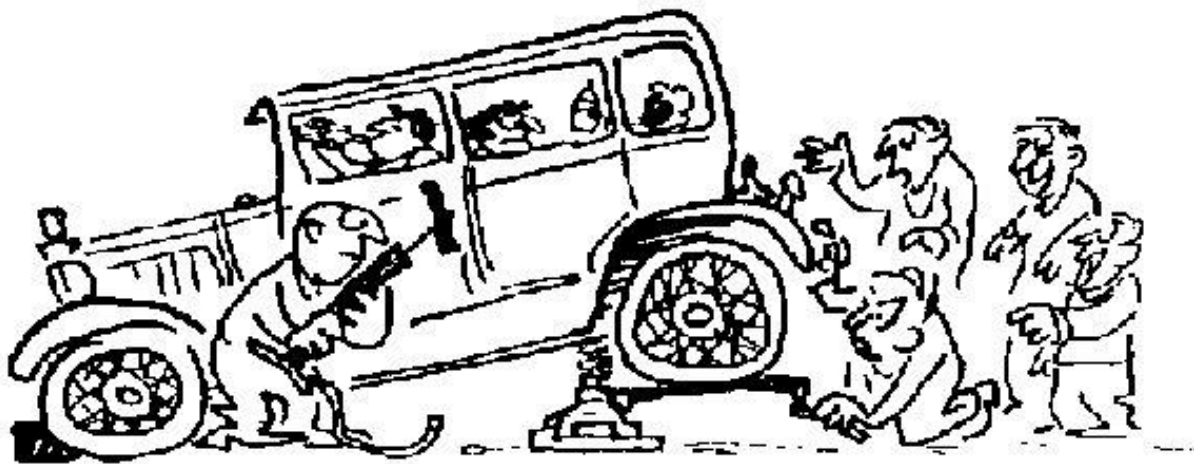
Depart from hotel at 6:00 pm. We have a reserved area. Order from menu.

TECHNICAL TIPS



Jim's Tech Tip: Radiator Bolt Nuts

When installing a radiator, Ford's Service Bulletins reminds you:

- DO NOT DRAW RADIATOR BOLT NUTS DOWN TIGHTLY -

"When mounting a radiator do not draw the radiator bolt nuts down any farther than is necessary to lock the nut with the Cotter key. If these nuts are drawn down tightly it compresses the radiator to frame bolt Springs to such an extent that the flexible feature of the Springs is defeated and damage to the radiator invariably results."

"Recently the threaded end of the radiator bolt was reduced from 5/8" to 17/32" which makes it impossible to screw the nut down farther than the correct distance. See figure 764. However, as practically all cars are equipped with the former design bolts constant care must be exercised one screwing down the radiator bolt nuts."

Good advice. My Tech tip is this:

Before installing the radiator bolt, paint a thin white line across the end of the bolt to show the orientation of the drilled hole for the cotter pin. Later, when you are tightening the nut it gives you a way to orient the drilled hole in the bolt "front to back" so that it is easy to slip the cotter key in and bend it over. Once the nut is on the bolt, it is hard to see the little hole and it can be very frustrating to put the cotter pin in.

I hope that helps get your radiator installed a bit faster and easier.

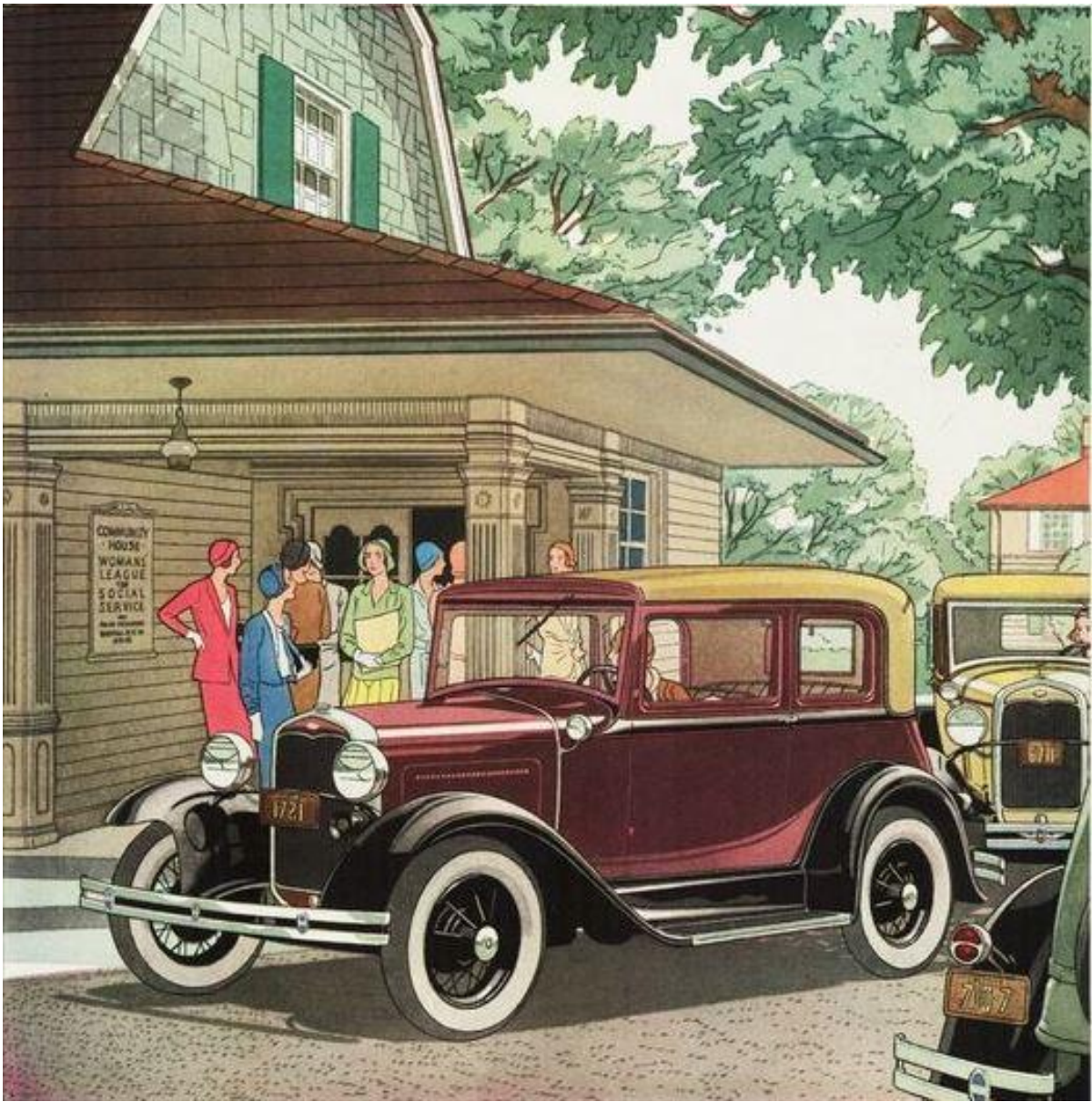
